About the Proposal

We believe that there is the opportunity to develop a solar farm, housing the panels at ground level and on the same land as the wind turbines. At this stage we anticipate the plans will:



Include over 53,000 solar PV panels



Cover approx. 30 hectares of land



Provide a community benefit package totalling £13,500 a year – index linked



Have a generating capacity of up to 27MW

We have been talking to residents, local groups and stakeholders and gathering feedback that will, alongside the results of our technical assessments, inform the final design that we hope to submit to the Scottish Government later in the year.
